

## **YSSA GAME FORFEIT/RESCHEDULING POLICY**

If team is unable to field enough players to play on the night scheduled they must contact the league coordinator and the opposing coach (s). This should be done at the earliest time possible. (League – so that if possible we can shift umpires around to other diamonds)

The game (s) will be considered a forfeit unless the reason is for a school-related function only. No other exceptions will be considered (ex: sports camps, church camps, etc.) The game can then be re-scheduled, by the league coordinators' directions, at the earliest time possible. (Must be able to arrange umpires for the rescheduled game.) The school related function must affect 3 or more players on the team.

The score for a forfeit game will be recorded as a 7-0, for purposes of keeping league standings.

In the event of a rained out game – only after 2 or more games have been rained out, will the games be rescheduled. Teams will be notified of rescheduled games/time/diamonds. A minimum of full 2 innings must be played for a game to be called a complete game.

Games may be called due to darkness. This will be at the discretion of the League officials. (after consultation with Umpire – on the diamond, Umpire-In-Charge (UIC) and YSSA League officials) Game will only be allowed to complete if the minimum 2 innings have not been completed. In the event of a game being called in the middle of an inning, the final score would be determined by score at end previous completed inning.
